

Let's **compost** green residue



Follow the collection schedule

Wednesdays, from April 24 to May 29;
from September 18 to November 20

Dispose of your green residue using paper bags; it will later be turned into compost and used to beautify your neighborhood.

GREEN RESIDUE ACCEPTED

- residue from cleaning gardens, vegetable gardens and fruit trees
- grass clippings
- evergreen branches (maximum of 1 m in length and 5 cm in diameter)
- dead leaves

REFUSED MATERIALS

- dirt and stones
- deciduous tree branches (to be collected separately)
- tree stumps and trunks
- food residue
- animal litter

ACCEPTED CONTAINERS

- reusable rigid containers
- paper bags

COLLECTION POINTS

Street collection

Green residue must be placed in front of the property, in the same location as household waste. Containers may be placed along the street between 8 p.m. the evening before and 7 a.m. on collection day.

ÉCOCENTRES

Green residue can be dropped off at one of Montreal's écocentres. For more information, please visit: ville.montreal.qc.ca/ecocentres

WARNING!

In order to address emerald ash borer infestation, deciduous tree branches will be picked up separately from green residue. To dispose of them, please call 311.
